

EAST YORKSIRE MIXED GOLF WEEK - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility -

The event is open to golfers who are members any golf club that is recognised by their country's governing body. Players must have a current competition handicap at the time of the event starting.

Entry / entry forms -

Entries must be submitted on the official entry form either by email or post. Entry forms can be requested from Andy Woodhead at adwoodhead1964@outlook.com . Entries will only be accepted upon receipt of the completed entry form and full payment of the entry fee. Places will be issued on a first come, first served basis.

Format -

The event will be four rounds of Mixed betterball golf using the stableford scoring system. Each pair to consist of one male and one female with an official club competition handicap.

Handicaps limits will be 28 for Men and 36 for ladies with an allowance of 90% for each round.

Start times -

Specific tee times and playing partners may be requested and will be allocated where possible, otherwise tee times for day one will be allocated according to distance travelled. In either case times will be notified by email and posted on the website of each hosting club one week in advance of the start date.

Prizes

Prizes will be presented to the leading pairs based on the 72 hole aggregate stableford score. There will also be prizes for the leading sores on each day. There will be only one prize per person permitted. Where someone would have won two prizes they will be awarded the higher valued prize and the next pair will be promoted up the winners list. The main prizes will be in the form of vouchers that can be redeemed at any of the four participating clubs and will be valid for a period of 13 months from day of issue. Prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of play on the final day.

Decisions on ties -

The event will be run under the rules of golf as laid down by the R&A.

In the event of a tie for the 72 hole event, these will be decided on best last round, best last 36 holes, best last 54 holes, and then, if needed the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 then hole by hole from the first hole of the last round.

For each of the day prizes, ties will be decided by last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 then hole by hole from the first hole of the round in question.

Local rules and course presentation

The organising committee will ask each hosting club to present the course as they see fit and agree to observe the local rules as laid down by the hosting club.

Dress code -

The dress code of each individual club should be observed. For clarification please contact the host club or visit their website (details below)

Registration -

There will be a registration desk situated in the lounge of each golf club on the day of hosting where competitors will be required to check in and collect their scorecards. They will be issued with any local rules and information relating to any spot prizes. Score cards should be returned to the check in desk upon completion of your round where a leaderboard will be available.

Bad weather

In the event of bad weather, we will suspend / resume play in accordance with R&A guide lines and, if necessary, adopt the host club evacuation plan (usually a hooter to signal the suspension of play and return to the clubhouse without delay).

In the event of the course becoming unplayable to the extent that play has to be abandoned for the day, the scores will be discarded in respect of the 72 hole event but if more than 50% of the field have finish the day prizes will be awarded based on the completed scores.

Course closed - procedure for refunds etc

Should the course be closed and prevent the completion of play, those who have not completed their round will be entitled to a refund of £20 per incomplete / abandoned round. Meals at each club will still be served starting 4 ½ hours after the first match was due to tee off. Any refund will be issued as a credit against future participation in the event.

Disputes

In the event of any disputes the organising committee's decision will be final

Practice rounds -

Practice rounds will be available in the week preceding the tournament at a charge of £25 per round and will be subject to the availability of tee times. Please contact the individual clubs directly to book.

Disclaimer / Insurances -

The organising Committee will not accept any responsibility or liability for injury, loss or damage how so ever sustained and recommend that players ensure they have adequate personal insurance to cover any eventuality.
